

Arch. Tetsuo HARADA was born in Osaka, Japan and graduated from Department of Architecture, Kyoto University. He had joined Takenaka Corporation in 1986.

Currently he is the General Manager of Building Design Department of Takenaka Corporation in Osaka and also teaches at Osaka University. In all of the cutting-edge commercial buildings that arch. Harada has designed, the connection of architecture with city and nature is the main theme. It is based on wisdom in Japanese traditional urban dwellings, as represented by "Machiya", a highly sophisticated environmental architecture in high-density cities.

Abeno Harukas is the tallest building in Japan and one of the world's tallest buildings directly over a railway terminal. It is a high-density urban complex incorporating a department store, art museum, college, clinic, office, hotel, observatory and roof top gardens above the railway terminal. At about 300 meters hight, Abeno Harukas is the future of multifunctional urban space in the sky.

Niek Roozen has been a landscape architect since 1974. He and

his team have worked, both nationally and internationally, on a

variety of projects such as city parks, horticulture exhibitions

and theme parks.

In 2005, landscape architect Niek Roozen was appointed the General Advisor of the Shenyang International Horticultural Exhibition 2006. After realising this successfully Niek Roozen BV made the designs of the urban green structure of the new residential areas like: Changbai, Manrong and Hunnan in cooperation with Shenyang Landscape Institute and Arktree

Landscape designs were made for the Hunnan Baita Park, Mozi Mountain Park and the design for Hun River North and South. For new residential area Hunnan (500.000 inhabitants) the design was made for the main axis with a length of 4,5 km. Recently.

At this moment the designs are being made for 10 km2 The Xiu lake Wetland park and the Shenyang National Forest Park.
